| Operating Roles | OR .01 | 7 /8 | <p>Node Operator</p> <p>a. Any entity operating an openIDL node on the openIDL network for their organization or on behalf of another organization(s)</p> <p>b. Node Operators could include openIDL, a Member of openIDL, an associate Member of openIDL or an Infrastructure Provider providing "node as a service" solutions to Members</p> <p>c. Node Operators are approved by the GB and TSC and are required to be Members or Associate members in good standing</p>   |  |
| Operating Roles | OR .02 | 7 /8 | <p>Node Owner</p> <p>a. The owner of a node on the openIDL network, regardless of where the Node is located (AWS, on-prem, etc.)</p> <p>b. Node owners could be Members, Associate Members, openIDL or Infrastructure Providers (Carriers, Stat Agents, States or openIDL itself)</p> <p>c. Node Owners are responsible for the maintenance, availability, uptime and in-consensus operation within the openIDL network.</p> <p>d. Node Owners can have the following capabilities derived from owning a Node:</p> <p>i. Receiving Data Calls</p> <p>ii. Responding to Data Calls</p> <p>iii. Contributing Data</p> <p>iv. Archiving Data</p> <p>v. Understanding the provenance and custody of data provided</p> |  |
| Operating Roles | OR .03 | 7 /8 | <p>Node User</p> <p>a. Any entity using the openIDL network for the following purposes:</p> <p>i. Adding a data call (requesting data) to the network (States)</p> <p>ii. Adding an extraction pattern to the network (Stat Agents, Carriers)</p> <p>iii. Responding to a data call on the network (Carriers)</p> <p>iv. Contributing Data to the network (Carriers)</p> <p>v. Storing data on the network (Carriers, States, Stat Agents)</p> <p>vi. Processing data on the network (Stat Agents, Academics, etc.)</p>   |  |
| Operating Roles | OR .04 | 7 /8 | <p>Network Operator (openIDL)</p> <p>a. Network Operator, in this case openIDL organization, manages and maintains the ongoing operation of the openIDL network</p> <p>b. Network Operator has the following capabilities/Roles:</p> <p>i. Certificate Authority: providing operating certificates to Node Operators, adding new Nodes to the Network, certifying existing nodes on the network, revoking nodes access to the Network</p> <p>ii. Monitoring: Continuous review of the "state of the network", network health, throughput and individual Node performance /health</p> <p>c. Network Operator does not respond to Data Calls and does not contribute Data to the openIDL network</p>                |  |
| Operating Roles | OR .05 | 7 /8 | <p>Network User</p> <p>a. Network Users are employees of Members, Associate Members or Infrastructure Partners</p> <p>b. Network Users can</p> <p>i. add data calls, extraction patterns to their node</p> <p>ii. review data calls, extraction patterns</p>  |  |
